Country Estate Wins Design Award



Julian Jacobs Architects Ltd., of Toronto, bas won the 1989/90 residential design award (single-family bome) from Canadian House & Home Magazine.

The award-winning project is a 7,000-square-foot (12,000 square feet with garages and indoor pool complex) country bome in Uxbridge, Ontario. The design combines a farmbouse concept with contemporary architecture, barmonizing with the local topography.

The selection jury commented that the project "is a combination of natural materials such as stone (exterior and interior walls, terrace and hearth), pine (interior beams and columns) and a profusion of natural light (skylight, gallery, glassed-in porch) situating the house in its natural environment and integrating the out-of-doors into the design of the home.
